Our Early Years Team love teaching at St Matthias and auickly build positive relationships with parents and children new to the unit. Opening Times

St Matthias Nursery

9am—12 noon Morning Session 12noon—3pm Afternoon session.

All children are entitled to 15 hours nursery funding and we also accept those who are eligible for 30 hour funding. Please speak to the school office if you require more information.

Nursery Lunch will be taken at 12.00pm. Children staying over the lunch period have the option to bring their own packed lunch or to have a pre booked hot or cold school meal for £2.30.

Our Nursery children are welcome to attend extra nursery sessions at a charge of £13.50 for the three hour session subject to availability.

If your child is booked in for a session for a term then you will have to pay for that session even if you can't make one. This is to ensure that we have the correct child:staff ratios in place.

Our Nursery children are also able to utilise our Whizz Kids wrap around childcare. For more information speak to the school office.
