

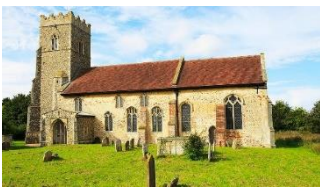
KNOWLEDGE BUILDING BLOCKS

A church is where Christians go.



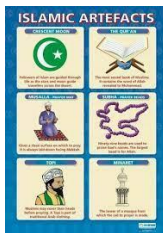
A Synagogue is where Jewish people worship.

 Jew	A person whose traditional religion is Judaism	 Synagogue	A Jewish place of worship.
 sacred	Something that is sacred is believed to be holy and to have a special connection with God	 artefact	Something that has been made.
 holy	God is holy, which means He is distinct from every other thing.	 precious	Something of great worth or value.
