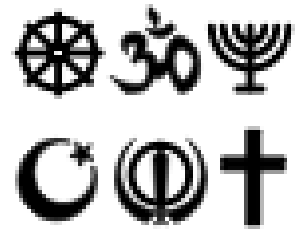


KNOWLEDGE BUILDING BLOCKS

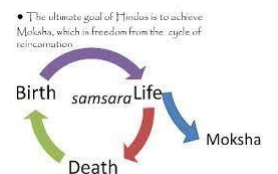
The story of Job is in the Christian and Jewish scriptures. It tells a story of suffering and keeping faith with God.

 reincarnation	The belief that people are born again after death.	 samsara	The Hindu belief that humans are in a cycle of death and rebirth.
