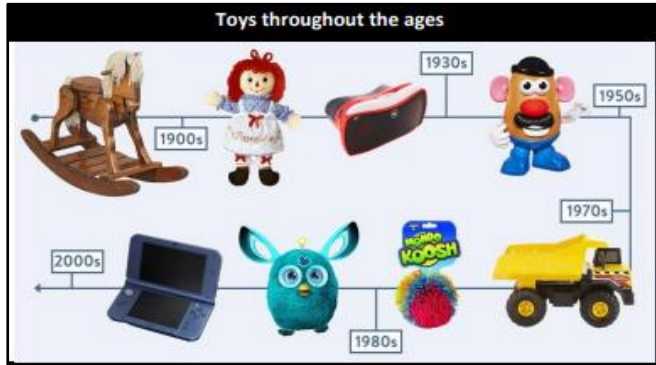

Key Knowledge

- Toys are the objects that we play with. They can be anything from a cardboard box to porcelain dolls and powerful computers.
- Toys have existed for thousands of years. They were made out of materials available at the time, depending on how much money you had
- Modern toys are mostly made from plastic and many are now electronic.
- Whilst some toys are the same, many are different as they rely on technology to work so toys can do clever things.
- Looking at what a toy is made from can help work out how old it is.

Victorian Toys

Toys in the Victorian age were made mostly of wood, paper and metal.

Popular Victorian toys were clockwork trains, rocking horses, train sets, dolls. Poorer children had toys such as peg dolls, wooden boats. Playground games were popular such as tag, hopscotch and hoops.
