SALVATION *Where, on 'The Big Frieze' can you see this frame?*

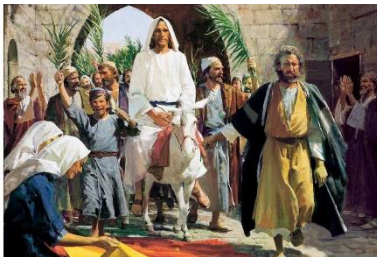
The Easter story for Christians leads to the idea of new life.

Christians believe that Jesus came back to life on the Sunday after his death.

Christians believe Jesus died on the cross so that they could have a new life with God in heaven after they die. 'Salvation'.



Christians believe heaven is a place of joy.



Holy Week is the week between Palm Sunday and Easter.

Palm Sunday is when Jesus arrived in Jerusalem.



Good Friday is when Jesus died on the cross.

<p>incarnation</p>	<p>The birth of Jesus - God the Son in human flesh.</p>	<p>cross</p>	<p>Vertical and horizontal bars Represents the cross that Jesus died on.</p>
<p>Holy Week</p>	<p>The last week of Jesus' earthly life from Palm Sunday</p>	<p>crucifix</p>	<p>A cross with an image/figure of Jesus on it.</p>
<p>worship</p>	<p>Worship is about people showing how much God is worth to them.</p>	<p>suffering</p>	<p>Undergoing pain, grief or damage.</p>
<p>festival</p>	<p>A day or period of celebration marking a special event or time.</p>	<p>forgiveness</p>	<p>The act of forgiving (feeling no anger or resentment for wrong doings).</p>
<p>symbol</p>	<p>Usually a mark or picture representing something else. E.g. The cross is a symbol of the Crucifixion.</p>	<p>Lent</p>	<p>From Ash Wednesday to Easter Saturday The weekdays are sometimes devoted to fasting or giving something up to remember the 40 days Jesus fasted in the wilderness.</p>
