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### Dear Parents and Carers,

It was lovely to see so many parents at our Harvest Service this week; thank you for attending. We celebrated our Value of Thankfulness during the service, reflecting on our families, school and community. Each class took a different focus within the service and prepared all the work themselves. 

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### **Outside Achievements**




