It was a super opportunity to share ideas, network with other parents and enjoy a drink and biscuit while learning about children and their development. We look forward to seeing you on Tuesday!


#### **Young Leaders**




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## <u>Primary School Applications for children starting in Reception in September</u> <u>2023 – the closing date is 15th January 2023</u>

Time is running out for parents and carers to submit their applications for children starting school in September 2023. Applications close at **midnight on the** 

**15th of January 2023** and parents hoping to be offered a place for Primary, First, Infant, Junior and Middle school in September, should apply before the deadline.
