### **Speech and Language – Listening Games**

Last week we looked at the four rules of good listening "listening to ALL the words" "looking at the person who is talking" "sitting still" and "staying quiet".

For children to develop listening skills they need to practise them. Playing games where children have to find a sound are a fun way of helping children learn to listen.

Here's an example of a listening game to play at home with younger children:

### Outdoor listening game

This listening game that works best outdoors. Stand still and ask everyone to close their eyes. Listen to the sounds that you hear. One player names a sound that they can hear. Everyone points to the sound. Then on the count of 3 everyone opens their eyes. Are you all pointing in the same direction?
