## Polite Reminders

Please can I remind parents not to block driveways or access to houses when you are parking at the start and the end of the day. The residents must have access to their driveways at all times. Thank you.

May I also remind children and parents that ANY type of scooter, whether a push scooter or electric scooter, that they MUST NOT be ridden in the playground; they MUST be pushed until you reach the public pathway. Thank you.

This is also a message that we have received about e-scooters from the police: 'The difference between an E-scooter and an E-bike is that E-bike motors only work whilst the pedals are being turned by the rider. If the rider stops pedalling then the motor also stops. On an E-scooter, the motor propels the scooter without any pedalling. These scooters are legal in some towns where they have specific bi-laws in place to allow their usage. Malvern is not one of those towns, so you risk having your E-scooter seized and destroyed if you are caught riding it around Malvern.'


