NSPCC Speak Out and Stay Safe

We had the delights of Ant and Dec deliver their virtual assembly with the NSPCC this week linked to 'Speaking Out and Staying Safe.' The children were delivered the message with 'Buddy the speech bubble' that all children have the right to speak out and stay safe. If they are worried about something, no matter how big or small, the children were told they could talk to a trusted adult. This adult could be in school or outside of school.

They were also reminded of 'Childline' a great resource for children to be able to share worries or concerns if they don't have someone to talk to.

The children then engaged in a lesson about 'Speaking Out and Staying Safe' which incorporated discussion and games. Then designed a poster to promote Childline, sharing the telephone number and why they might want to contact Childline. They were all very reflective and thoughtful during the assembly while this important message was shared.

Speech and Language – Vocabulary

Vocabulary learning is very important for taking part in discussions, understanding topic work and to understand the meaning when reading. When we learn new words we link them to words we already know. Here is a fun game for home to practise linking words by their meaning!

Word Associations

One player starts by saying a word. The next player says a word that is related to the first word. It can be related in any way. If another player cannot see how the words are related they can challenge and the connection needs to be explained. Keep going until a word is repeated or a connection cannot be explained. Here's an example: Egypt – Mummy – Dad – beard – Santa Claus – Christmas – trees – leaves


Attendance The table below shows class attendance statistics for this week.
