



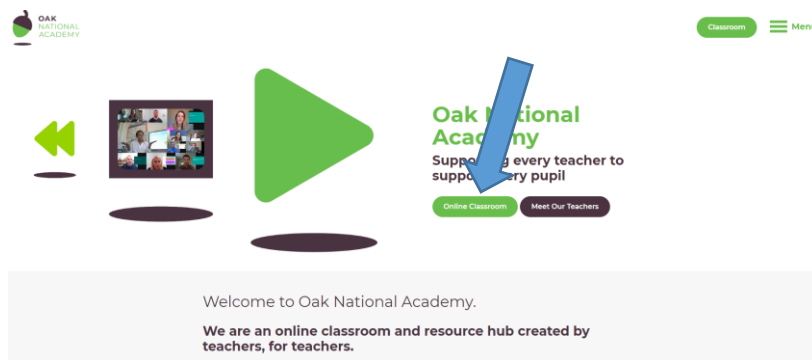
Dear Parents and Carers,

Home Learning Update

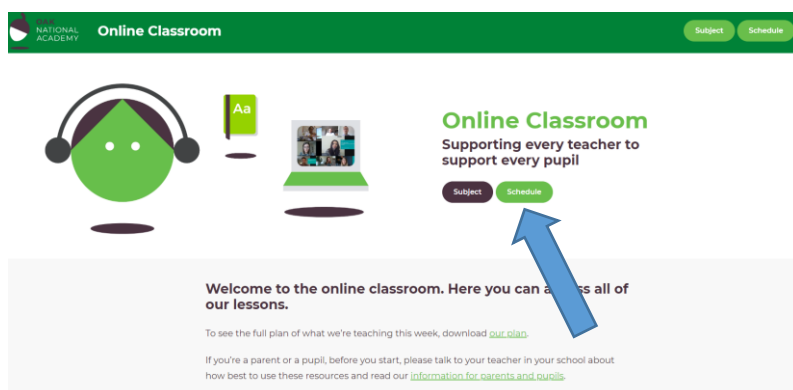
Following the Government's announcement on Sunday 19th April 2020 that there is no confirmed date for schools to reopen to all children, we are now moving most of our home learning online. The Oak National Academy are providing daily lessons for all year groups and this is how most of your home learning should take place from now on. Instructions for accessing the lessons are below:

How to access the online classroom:

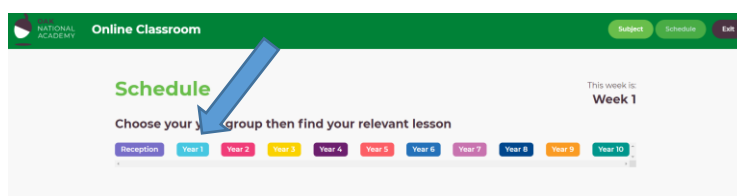
1. Go to the website <https://www.thenational.academy/>
2. Click on Online Classroom



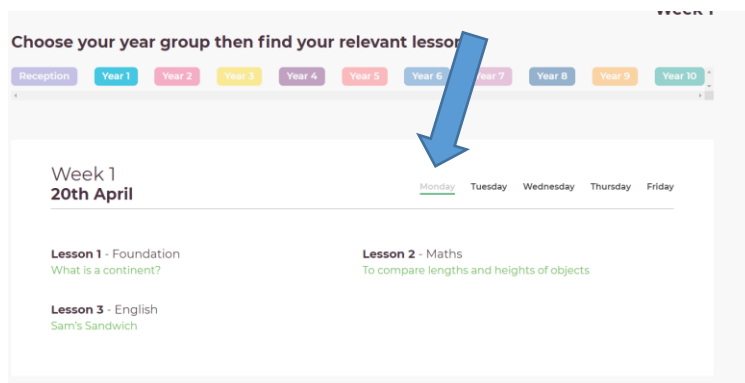
3. Click on Schedule



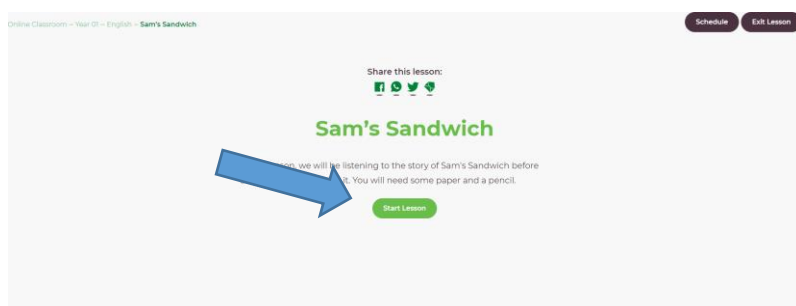
4. Click on your child's year group



5. Select the day that you are on (do the lessons in order)



6. Click on each lesson to watch and listen to the teacher explaining the activities. Press 'Start Lesson' to get going.



You need to do the lessons in order as they build up over the week. Don't worry if you start late – just click on the first day and work your way through the lessons.

You will continue to receive a weekly update from your child's class teacher about home learning and this will be sent to you through ClassDojo.
