

Reception Class Home Learning Plan Weekly expectation 15.06.20-19.06.20

Please find below this week's Home Learning for Reception Class. We are using online learning provided by Oak National Academy and phonics lessons delivered by the Department for Education (https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCP_FbjYUP_UtldV2K_-niWw/videos)

Read with your family every day for 30 minutes.

Read your keyring words and if you have access to the internet then head to www.phonicsplay.co.uk to play our tricky word trucks – phase 2 and 3. If your child can read them then record a video of them reading them and post it on Tapestry! I will then send you the next phase. Phase 4 and 4 are also on the Phonics Play website ☺

Please continue to use the Oak National Academy site to access daily English, Maths and Foundation subject lessons. You can find the lessons here: <https://www.thenational.academy/> To access the lessons, click on 'Online Classroom' > 'Schedule' > 'Reception' and select the day. If you feel that your child is not



engaging with this then you can head to whiterose maths or classroom secrets for activities. You can also message Mr Salmon on Tapestry and he will send you activities for your child.

Remember your magic five when writing and use your phonics skills ☺

This week can you go on a bug hunt and write down the names of the minibeasts that you find. Then you could write a report about your favourite one. I have added a template onto Tapestry to help you with this.

Maths

Have a look at whiterose maths for this week's challenge. Week 4, 5 and 6 link really well to our minibeasts topic and are based on the stories The Snail and the Whale, The Very Busy Spider and SuperWorm. Choose one that you like and work through it in the week. I have also added an addition activity and counting activity on Tapestry linked to minibeasts. You could also go on a walk and look for minibeasts, create a tally chart and turn it into a graph when you get home.

Minibeasts

We will be focussing on Minibeasts this week. We will be sharing Mad About Minibeasts (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=SW-7MgHEZOE>) at school and will then be finding out about Spiders, Ladybirds and Bees. What can you find out about these minibeasts? Spend a day researching each one.

Art – Create your own representation of a minibeast. We will be making paper plate spiders and will be getting messy with bees and ladybirds.



PE – For this half-term we are asking all children in school to take part in the Worcestershire Virtual Schools Games. This is a sporting event and there is a new challenge each week. I hope you all had fun doing the speed bounce last week. This week the challenge is the Throwing Challenge.
