Read with your family every day for 30 minutes.

Read your keyring words and if you have access to the internet then head to <u>www.phonicsplay.co.uk</u> to play our tricky word trucks – phase 2 and 3. If your child can read them then record a video of them reading them and post it on Tapestry! I will then send you the next phase. Phase 4 is also on the Phonics Play website [©]

If you feel that your child is not



engaging with this then you can head to whiterose maths or classroom secrets for activities. You can also message Mr Salmon on Tapestry and he will send you activities for your child.

Remember your magic five when writing and use your phonics skills $\textcircled{\mbox{$\odot$}}$

Write an information book about an owl. Remember a lovely picture on the front page. Your page headings could be Where owls live, What owls eat, How have they adapted to be nocturnal, An interesting fact. You could do one page a day.

Maths

Make your own clock this week and add the correct times. Remember to talk about morning, afternoon, evening and use other time related language. Talk about minutes and hours and how we use these to measure time. How many star jumps can you do in one minute? Do you think you could do more or less in 3 minutes? Why? You could also talk about seconds. How many words can you write in 30 seconds?

Nocturnal animals

We will be focussing on owls this week. A lovely story is Owl Babies and this can be found on youtube. Could you research different types of owls and choose your favourite to write a report about? Where does it live? What does it like it eat? Why is it good at being nocturnal?

Art – Create your own representation of an owl. There are lots of lovely ways to do this and you can choose lots of different media and materials to help you.



PE – For this half-term we are asking all children in school to take part in the Worcestershire Virtual Schools Games. This is a sporting event and there is a new challenge each week. I hope you all had fun doing the speed bounce last week. This week the challenge is the Target Challenge.
