Reading

Read with your family every day for 30 minutes.

Read your keyring words and if you have access to the internet then head to www.phonicsplay.co.uk to play our tricky word trucks – phase 2 and 3. If your child can read them then record a video of them reading them and post it on Tapestry! I will then send you the next phase. Phase 4 is also on the Phonics Play website 😊

Please continue to use the Oak National Academy site to access daily English, Maths and Foundation subject lessons. You can find the lessons here: <https://www.thenational.academy/> To access the lessons, click on 'Online Classroom' > 'Schedule' > 'Reception' and select the day. If you feel that your child is not engaging with this then you can head to whiterose maths or classroom secrets for activities. You can also message Mr Salmon on Tapestry and he will send you activities for your child.

When writing this week can you have a go at writing something that you have done every day. You could write 'On Monday I read The Hungry Caterpillar. On Tuesday we went on a walk and saw some butterflies....'

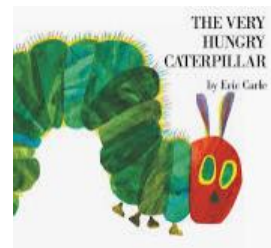
Days of the Week
