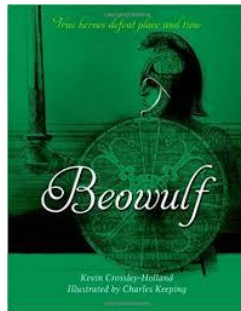
In the morning, you will enter the school using the Upper Key stage 2 playground. You will find your new locker just outside the classroom. Your name will be on it when you arrive.
