Year 1 History Trip to The Commandery

As part of our History topic on the Battle of Worcester we have organised a trip to 'The Commandery' in Worcester. The trip is arranged for 9th December 2021.

The children will have the opportunity to experience three aspects of the civil war;

Get Ready for Battle!

Uncovering the different roles the common soldier played in the Civil War by learning about the pikemen, the musketeers and the cavalry officers. Children can literally step into their shoes by putting on replica armour and handling replicas of the weapons. Then, it's time to report for training, becoming Civil War soldiers.

Life in Stuart Times

Learning more about what life was like in England when the Civil War was taking place. This interactive session involves going back in time to give an insight into how people lived. Discovering more about food, equipment and religion during this period using replica artefacts and sources.

A Tour to Fort Royal

Why was Worcester such an important place during the Civil War? Using maps the children will take a walk up to Fort Royal Park, unearth the significant details that led up to the Battle of Worcester and understand what happened in the aftermath. Learning about the role the city of Worcester played.
